in Bayreuth, from 27 to 31 August 2022

We celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Bavarian Youth Chess organisation.

Accommodation:	The accommodation of the players and carers takes place in the newly built youth hostel Bayreuth in mainly shared rooms. For carers, parents and trainers limited double rooms are available. The tournament also takes place in the same building. Accommodation outside the hostel is <b>not possible</b> .

Journey transportation:	by train Nuremberg - Bayreuth - Hof, from the station 25 min walking distance, FLIXBUS stop
Car:	A9 Munich - Leipzig - Berlin, exit Bayreuth Süd in Direction University or A70 Schweinfurt - Bayreuth
Parking:	18 free parking spaces, electric parking and 2 Bus parking available, larger parking spaces are at the nearby swimming pool or university grounds
Airport:	Nuremberg "Albrecht Dürer" (84 km)
Ship:	romantic journey on the Rhine-Main-Danube Canal to Bamberg and then public transport or bicycle

We invite several (neighboring) countries to our under 12 anniversary tournament. The number of participating teams is limited to ten for both boys/open and girls. Each country can report one team per gender, Bavaria may provide two as the host. An additional team may be set up to straighten the field.

Supervision: Each association must send at least one adult who also takes over the supervisory duty for the children. The BSJ does not supervise the children of other associations.

Prevention: All state supervisors, organizers and arbitrators must have dealt with the topic of prevention of sexual violence (e.g. training etc.).

Alcohol: Adults are expected to have an exemplary alcohol consumption. For Minors there is a strict alcohol ban, even if the law differs.

Tournaments: It is played in two tournaments "Girls" and "Open".

Teams: Each team consists of four under 12 regular players (year 2010+). Each Association may report two substitute players for each reported team.

Report: The mandatory registration of the teams **must be completed by 1 May 2022 including a deposit of 200 € per team.**  
**The exact team composition including supervisor and substitute player has up to July 8, 2022, to Johannes Pfadenhauer.**

Modus: Swiss system with seven rounds

Time control: 90 min / 40 moves + 15 min + 30 s/move

Rating calculation: The tournament will be calculated for DWZ and ELO.

Games input: It is planned to play with live boards.

Commenting: It is planned to set up a (time-delayed) comment.

Tournament rules: It is played according to the FIDE rules.

Corona: We are guided by the current Bavarian legislation and the Hygiene concepts of the youth hostel and the Bavarian Chess Federation (Bayerischer Schachbund, BSB).

Grace period: Zero minutes. At the first - up to 15-minute delay - in the tournament in addition to the delay time a penalty of 15 minutes is imposed. At the second delay in the tournament, the game will be lost.
